Home for Texas Lavender Hills Farm + Market, the Hunter House sits just outside of the quaint town of Blanco-the lavender capital of Texas. A simple and straight-forward house, it uses rugged materials to create a relaxed but elegant home in the Texas Hill Country.

The "L" shaped plan wraps around the yard to frame year-round views across the hills of Central Texas. The house is conceptually an assembly of two buildings-the "farm house" and the adjacent "barn". By using local stone, classic wood detailing and plenty of windows, the farm house has a more refined, finished look where it houses the living spaces. Conversely, the barn is clad in corrugated metal to give it the look of agrarian utility; thus, housing the more utilitarian spaces.
